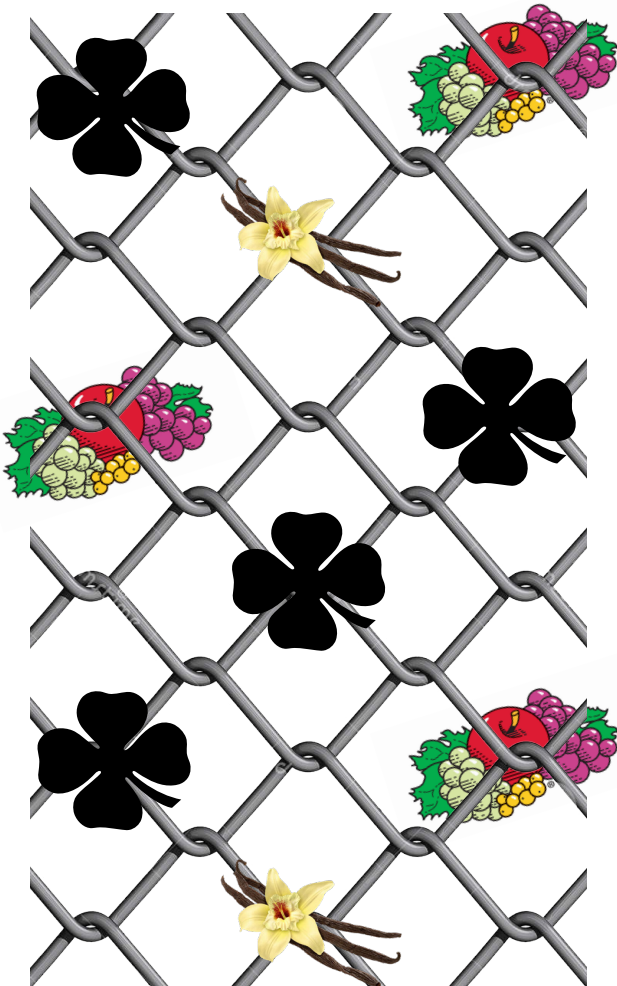


John Amelchenko
